- **Regular weekly dance**
 - Every Sunday evening (except 5th Sundays) year-round, 6:30—9:30 pm, all levels of experience welcome. Newcomer orientation at 6:10. There are occasional departures from the regular schedule—check web site.
- **Netherfield Ball: Saturday, August 27, 2016**
 - Especially for novices. Instruction, easy Ball dances, elegant refreshments, vendors of Regency accessories.
- **Masquerade Ball: Saturday, October 29, 2016**
 - A costume Ball, beginner friendly, the weekend before Halloween. Proceeds benefit the English dance series.
- **Turning of the Year Ball: Sunday, January 1, 2017**
 - An elegant, dressy affair celebrating the beginning of the new year. Held in the historic Jonathan Child house. Pre-registration required.
- **Demonstration group—the Meryton Assembly Dancers**
 - Performs in period costume at various events during the year and encourages audience participation. More at dancelikejaneasthen.com
- **Jane Austen Ball Weekend: May 6&7, 2017**
 - On Saturday, an afternoon Ball practice, a potluck, and an evening experienced English dance (not restricted to the Regency period).
 - On Sunday, a morning Ball dance review followed by a luncheon and an afternoon fancy dress Ball featuring English Country dances of the Regency period (and delicious refreshments) in one of Rochester's most elegant ballrooms.
