CONTRA & ENGLISH DANCES

2018 Scholarship Application

Country Dancers of Rochester, Inc. (CDR) is an educational organization which is dedicated to the preservation, study, teaching, enjoyment and continuing evolution of English and American traditional and historical dance and dance music.

We at the CDR believe that those goals are furthered by providing financial support for members to gain experience and expertise that would directly benefit our community. Every year we provide scholarship support totaling \$500 to help cover the expenses of attendance at a dance-related event or activity (such as CDSS dance camp). CDR reserves the right to award scholarship money either in full to one applicant or in partial amounts to multiple applicants. Some events, such as CDSS camps, may also offer matching funds and applicants should indicate their intent to apply for such additional scholarships.

Preference will be given to applicants with the most potential to provide long term benefits to the CDR community by increasing their skills, knowledge and experience

Application Requirements:

- All applicants must be active members of CDR.
- Proposed scholarship activities **MUST** be related to English and American traditional and historical dance and/or music. A preference will be given to applications that are directly related to Contra or English Country dancing.
- Applicants must describe the benefit that his or her proposed activity will bring to the Country Dancers of Rochester community.

At the completion of the scholarship activity, all scholarship recipients are required to share their experience with the CDR community through a newsletter article, delivered within 60 days of the completion of the activity. Additionally, all scholarship recipients must serve on the CDR scholarship committee for two years.

The deadline for the CDR's scholarship application is February 28, 2018.

Applicants may wish to apply for a scholarship to a CDSS Dance camp. As a member organization with CDSS, CDR members receive priority consideration for admission to CDSS camps when there is high demand. Please note that some camps are not eligible for the CDR scholarship, and that in the event of multiple applications those directly related to Contra and English Country will receive preference.
