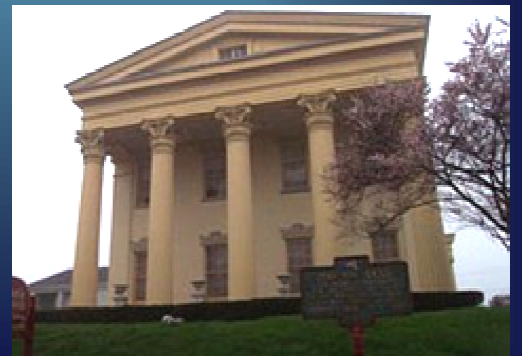

## Driving directions

From I490 headed West, take the Plymouth Ave. exit (#14) and continue straight onto Washington St. Go past the Child house on the left, turn left onto Broad Street, then left onto Goldsmith Place, a very small street with signs for Tango Café Dance and the Boys and Girls Club.

From I490 headed East, take the Allen St. exit (# 12), turn right onto Rt. 31 (Broad St.). Follow 31, jogging left under the expressway, then taking a slight right. Turn right onto Goldsmith Place.

## From Goldsmith Place

Turn right into the large parking lot behind the Jonathan Child House. Ignore the parking restriction signs -- it's OK to park there in the evening. The entrance to the Child House is on the North side of the building at the doorway with the two columns. If the weather is sloppy, we may be using a closer entrance (the door marked *Enter Here*),

## Cost

Admission is \$30, students or low income \$15, pre-registration strongly suggested, as this event usually sells out.

## Details

There are no changing rooms at the Child House -- we suggest you come dressed for the Ball. We will be dancing on gorgeous new oak floors. The first floor, where we will have refreshments, is handicapped accessible, but the dancing space on the second floor is not.

Dress: something festive or dressy is suggested. Regency clothing would look really nice in this lovely 1837 building, but it's certainly not required. Be comfortable!

Refreshments: savory snacks will be served from 6 to 6:30, as we gather, and there will be a longer refreshment break at 8:30. The planning committee will supply a sparkling punch and a start on the refreshment table. As at our regular dances, we encourage attendees to bring a sweet or savory delight to share. No alcoholic beverages, please -- CDR dance events are smoke and alcohol free.

## Getting home after the Ball

To get back on to I490 east, turn right out of Goldsmith, pass Washington, and make the next right onto Plymouth Ave. In about 3 blocks you'll see an entrance to I-490 E.

To get back onto I490 West, turn left out of Goldsmith and you will be on Broad St., Rt. 31. Follow Rt. 31 about half a mile until you see the entrance to I-490 W.
